1. Background

The financial year 2018-19 represents interesting opportunities and certain challenges for the province of the Punjab. The latest census results are out, and suggest that Punjab's population has hit 110 million; yet this translates into an overall decrease of around 2 percentage points in the national population having implications on future NFC shares. The province may have to cater to a larger size of absolute population and may have lesser resources at hand. The energy projects and investments are maturing, making it crucial than ever for the province to be prepared to manage these assets well. The scale of infrastructure investments and their complexity is now at the highest, which has ever been in the history of the province. CPEC's momentum has peaked and is now requiring a proactive response by the government on an increasing basis. The compliance work on SDGs must be paced up as a top priority, and given the diversity of its indicators; result oriented investments are required in social as well as productive sectors. Finally, it is crucial that the government begins to intensely monitor and evaluate its interventions and knit in the learnings to improve future planning.

To cope up with the above-mentioned challenges, Government of the Punjab is wishes to prepare a five-year strategic development plan (2018-2023) which sets the long-term direction for the implementation of its vision and mandate.

2. Objectives

The main objective of the consultancy is to develop a chapter for five-year development plan (2018-2023). The scope of work for the Consultant will include but not be limited to: -

- Formulate a chapter for five-year plan based on the sectoral priorities of Punjab (i.e. Social Sectors, Nutrition & Population Welfare, Agriculture & Livestock, Infrastructure, Industrial Competitiveness & CPEC) and in line with the targets set under Punjab Growth Strategy and Sustainable Development Goals.
- Finalize the Five-Year Plan (2018-2023) of Punjab

3. Proposed Methodology

The consultant in expected to apply an approach to the development of Five Year Plan that has to be very participatory and results based. The Consultant is expected to provide technical input, good practice in strategic planning, challenging assumptions and leading the document towards a comprehensive result framework that forms the basis of the plan. The emphasis of the plan will be on lessons learnt from previous development programmes and their application to the future by

the analysis of facilitating and hindering factors. In summary, the consultant will carry out the following broad activities, among others: -

- Review the existing documents and policies as well as any other relevant documents for consultation/reference, including Punjab Growth Strategy 2018, Punjab Economic Report 2017, ADP Strategy Paper White Paper on Budget 2017-2018, Annual Development Programmes, SDGs Framework, CPEC
- ii. Develop a draft Five Year Plan using an agreed upon outline.
- iii. Distribute the draft strategic plan to P&D Department and receive feedback
- iv. Finalize the plan incorporating the comments and feedback received.
